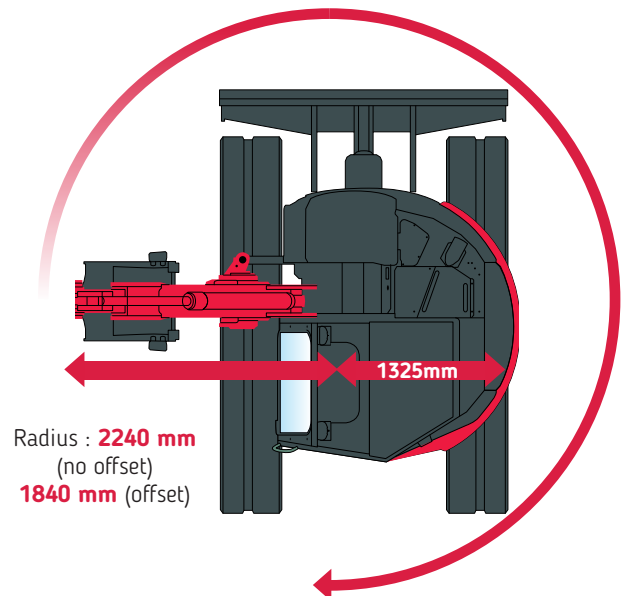
PERFECT FOR URBAN JOB SITES

EXCELLENT WEIGHT DISTRIBUTION, EXCEPTIONAL LIFTING FORCES

Thanks to a unique undercarriage design, alongside perfect weight distribution and a short tail overhang, the SV60-6B achieves outstanding stability and remarkable lifting capacities. The mini-excavator can carry a one ton load up to a 5.10m at 1.25m high. Available as an optional extra, an additional 200kg counterweight can further improve lifting performance.

X-SHAPED UNDERCARRIAGE

The X-shaped box section structure of the SV60's undercarriage ensures unbeatable torsional stiffness. The frame has been designed with maximum durability in mind, while the heavy-duty components ensure durability, reliability and long service intervals – resulting in a lower Total Cost of Ownership (TCO).

Thanks to Yanmar's unique experience and expertise, the SV60 delivers excellent performance while ensuring a low environmental impact. Combining unmatched power, flexibility and precision, it's the perfect partner for productivity – even when faced with the most complex tasks.



NEXT-GENERATION YANMAR ENGINE

With an output of 33.5 kW at 2,200 rpm, Yanmar's electronically-controlled 4TNV86CT-PBVA engine is the result of continued efforts to achieve technology advances in fuel consumption and emissions reduction.

- + An ECU manages rpm according to torque, effectively optimising the engine load. This not only saves fuel, but also improves efficiency.
- + Auto-deceleration technology (available as standard) allows the engine to revert to idle if the operator hasn't touched the operating levers for more than four seconds.
- + Eco-mode (available as standard) reduces the motor speed by 300rpm – thus further reducing fuel consumption.



HIGH-PERFORMANCE TRANSMISSION

The SV60-6B benefits from a drive motor that develops 10% more torque, improved cycle times and impressive productivity – especially when it comes to levelling applications. All-new 'automatic 2-speed' drive motors are included as standard, which shift up and down (in second speed) depending on the effort required. In result, the operator is presented with the optimum solution (in terms of speed or pushing force), which makes operation easier and further improves efficiency.

VIPPS HYDRAULIC SYSTEM

Featuring ViPPS (ViO Progressive 3 Pump System) hydraulics, which uses four hydraulic pumps, two variable displacement pumps and two gear pumps, (including one for joysticks), the SV60-6B delivers a total flow of 139.4l/min. A control valve, based on the ViPPS principle, cumulates the flow of separate pumps in order to obtain the optimal combination of speed, power, smooth operation and balance.

In result, the system allows operators to perform multiple tasks, even while travelling – the ultimate working tool!



EASE OF USE

ADJUSTABLE PROPORTIONAL CONTROL OF THE AUXILIARY CIRCUITS

The SV60-6B is fitted, as standard, with an auxiliary hydraulic circuit. Operated via a proportional control located on the joystick, this allows the flow and oil direction to be easily adapted. In addition, thanks to an easy-to-operate potentiometer, flow can be easily adjusted to meet the specific requirements of your attachments.

XXL SPACE

Unlike other models, the SV60-6B travel pedals are foldable and have been designed to deliver perfect ergonomics.

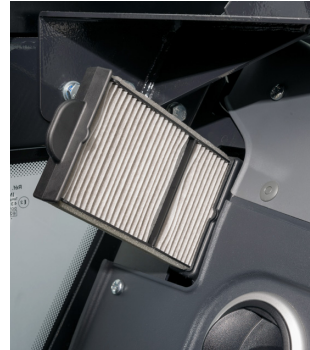

AIR CIRCULATION

With air condition fitted as standard, operators benefit from a pleasant working temperature – even in the most extreme weather conditions. Seven vents have been positioned around the cab to ensure air circulation uniformity, while a window demisting setting maximises operator efficiency.



Even the air filters have been located in easy-to-access spaces, to ensure quick and simple maintenance.



AIR SUSPENSION SEAT

Fitted with a fully-adjustable, air suspension seat (with headrest) as standard, the SV60-6B guarantees the highest levels of operator comfort – ensuring minimal fatigue while on the job site. Elsewhere, the roof window is fitted with an integrated sunshade for maximum comfort.

UNBEATABLE STORAGE

The SV60-6B incorporates numerous storage spaces, including bottle/cup holder, utility box, phone tray, document storage and even a dedicated lunchbox storage area behind the seat! All of these areas are located within arm's reach of the seat.



SETTING THE STANDARDS IN SAFETY

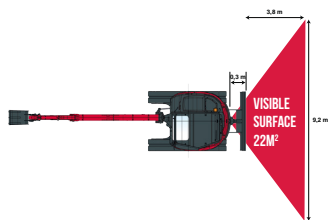


The SV60-6B cab has been designed to meet ROPS (Roll-Over Protective Structure) certification, as well as FOPS (Falling Object Protective Structure) level 1. The cab can be fitted with FOPS level 2 protection (front and top guard) as an optional extra.



360° VISIBILITY

In order to maximise operator safety and efficiency, the SV60-6B has been designed to provide 360° visibility. Alongside large glass panels, the roof window offers excellent visibility during loading and unloading, while three mirrors provide a complete view of the work area without the operator needing to leave their seat.



REAR VIEW CAMERA

As standard, the SV60-6B is fitted with a state-of-the-art rear view camera and 7" LCD screen. Fully-waterproof, night vision enabled and heated to ensure it doesn't freeze during the colder winter months, the camera boasts numerous settings, a mirror mode and even allows the option of fitting a second side camera.



ACCESSIBILITY

The SV60-6B has the largest cab entrance of any equivalent excavator on the market. This makes entering and exiting the cab easier and safer. Three handrails (marked 1, 2 and 3) are ideally positioned to match the operator's grip position, while a large footstep (with anti-slip technology) further improves safety on site.

RELIABILITY

Developed in Japan using best-in-class components, the SV60-6B is renowned for its reliability and long service intervals. The unique structure of the undercarriage, as well as the steel covers, provide optimum protection and a longer service life. In addition, the hose routing has been developed with durability in mind. These measures enhance the service life and reduce unnecessary machine downtime.

THE BEST PROTECTION ON THE MARKET

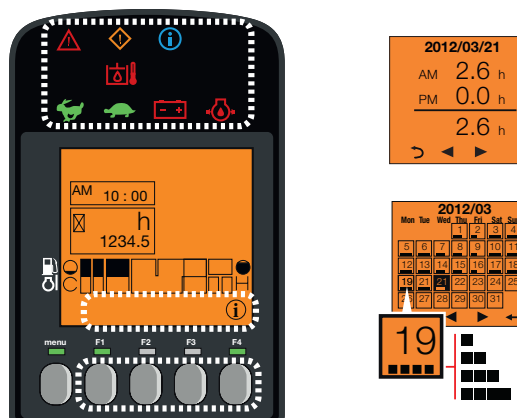
The SV60-6B benefits from complete cylinder protection. All tubes and rods are covered by a spring type steel plate, which further improves durability and minimises Total Cost of Ownership (TCO).



DIGITAL INTERFACE

Thanks to a state-of-the-art digital interface, the operator is informed (in real time) about exacting machine status details. Perfectly integrated into the right-hand console, the 3.3" screen provides the customer with useful information through LED lamps, or indications about important measures such as fuel consumption, fuel level and coolant temperature.

What's more, the interface informs the operator about maintenance intervals and works as a diagnostic tool by sending an error code and an information icon in the case of a malfunction.
